New Smyrna Beach Athletic Department Attendance Policy

Attendance will be checked for student athletes at each midterm progress report and end of quarter report card. If a student-athlete who is in season is above the allowable number of unexcused absences, they will receive an excessive unexcused absence suspension equivalent to 10 percent of their season competitions.

Example:

25 game season = 2 game suspension

10 game season = 1 game suspension

Attendance checks will occur on the following dates

Attendance Check Dates	Unexcused Absence Threshold
September 11 th (1 st quarter midterm)	More than 5 Unexcused Absences in any individual class.
October 10 th (end of 1 st quarter)	More than 10 Unexcused Absences in any individual class.
November 13 th (2 nd quarter midterm)	More than 15 unexcused absences in any individual class
December 20 th (end of 2 nd quarter)	More than 20 unexcused absences in an individual class.
February 12 th (3 rd quarter midterm)	More than 25 unexcused absences in any indivual class.
March 14 th (end of 3 rd quarter)	More than 30 unexcused absences in any individual class.
April 23 rd (4 th quarter midterm)	More than 35 unexcused absences in any individual class
May 14 th (last check of the year)	More than 40 unexcused absences in any individual class.

Any fall/winter sport underclassmen student-athlete (ones who do not participate in spring sports) who have more than 45 unexcused absences in any individual class on the last attendance check of the year, will receive an excessive unexcused absence suspension of 10 percent of their season competitions the following school year.

What does VCS consider an Excused Absences?

- brief illness/injury
- medical/dental appointments
- death of an immediate family member
- religious holiday of the specific faith of the student
- school-sponsored/related activity (school field trip, school athletic event)

Excused Absences- ANY EXCUSED ABSENCE MUST HAVE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTATION PROVIDED BY THE PARENT/GUARDIAN TO THE ATTENDANCE AND/OR ATHLETIC OFFICE WITHIN 1 WEEK OF THE ABSENCE FOR IT TO BE EXCUSED. IF THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTATION IS NOT PROVIDED THE ABSENCE WILL BE UNEXCUSED. IF ILLNESS REQUIRES THE STUDENT-ATHLETE TO BE ABSENT FROM SCHOOL (4 PERIODS), THEY WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PRACTICE OR PLAY IN A COMPETITION THAT DAY.

Athletic Department Excused Absences (Absences that are officially unexcused but will not count toward unexcused absences within the athletic attendance policy): Parents must still provide documentation of these absences to the athletic office prior to or within one week of the absence for it to be excused. DOCUMENTATION PROVIDED AFTER THIS TIME WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND ABSENCE WILL BE DEEMED UNEXCUSED

- College Visits
- Club travel tournaments

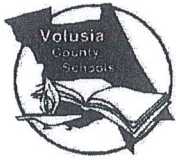
What is an Unexcused Absence?

- missing school bus/oversleeping
- shopping/pleasure/vacation trips
- excessive illness (without physician verification that medical condition justifies pattern)
- skipping (on or off campus)
- Failure to provide acceptable documentation for the absence within 1 WEEK OF ABSENCE

Vehicles used to transport students on school-sponsored activities, including privately-owned vehicles, shall meet federal safety standards for passenger cars or school buses. State Board of Education Rules prohibit the use of multi-purpose vehicles, including vans, mini-vans, pick-up trucks and four-wheel drive vehicles, which do not meet the federal safety standards for passenger cars or school buses to transport students on school-sponsored activities.

Motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight (GVW) of 10,000 pounds or less must provide seatbelts for each occupant.

Each vehicle must be occupied by eight or fewer passengers with each having a seatbelt securely fastened at all times the vehicle is in operation.

School Board Policy and Procedure Requirements

Prior to school-related activity/field trip, drivers will provide a certificate of liability (copy of insurance policy) to the school principal or designee which clearly indicates the group(s) liability coverage with minimum limit of \$25,000/\$50,000 for any claim or occurrence.
